Attractions in Stavern

Hall of remembrance (Minnehallen)

The hall was built after World War I to commemorate the fallen Norwegian sailors of the war. It is shaped as a pyramid and offers a superb view in all directions, both and the nearby islands. The guest harbour and the ocean is normally open from May to August, but even when it is closed, the surroundings and architecture makes the visit a great experience.



Stavernsodden Lighthouse (Stavernsodden Fyr)

Stavernsodden Lighthouse was first lit in 1865, and was automated in 1984. The lighthouse was listed as a protected site in 1997. Situated at the eastern side of the southern entrance to the harbour of Stavern, the light does not only mark the safe entrance to the harbour, but it's white sector to the east also marks the safe passage between Svenner and the mainland.



Stavern Fortress (Stavern Fort)

One of the most popular attractions in Stavern, Staverns Fortress was a military facility located on the island of Citadelloya in Stavern and served as an important base for Norwegian naval hero Tordenskjold and his fleet during the Great Northern War's final Norwegian phase from 1709 until 1720.



Svenner Lighthouse (Svenner Fyr)

Svenner Lighthouse was first lit in 1874 on the archipelago Svenner. The current tower was built in 1900. The lighthouse was listed as a protected site in 1997, and was automated in 2003.

Svenner is one of the most popular places for the locals. Svenner is a magical place in the summertime, and is perfect for a day full of swimming, crab fishing and sunbathing - all with a spectacular view.



Fredriksvern Shipyard (Fredriksvern Verft)

Fredriksvern Shipyard is one of Norway's most frequently visited attractions. More than 60 large vessels was built at the yard and it became the centre of military activity in Norway in the 1800's. Fredriksvern Shipyard is also the only fortification complex in Norway which throughout its time has accommodated all branches of the military service - the Navy, Army, Air Force and Home Guard. The complex saw military activity from 1750 right up to 2002.



Several galleries and museums have taken up permanent residence on the site of the Fredriksvern shipyard.

"The peace ships" is a sound and light artwork by Pavi Laakso on the Fredriksvern shipyard. The boats are placed upright and they all have the keel facing the sea.

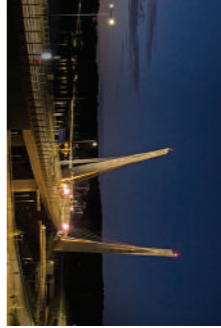

Lake Farris (Farrisvannet)

Despite its location by the coast, Farris is a fresh water lake that serves as a source of drinking water for 200,000 people. The lake is dammed by a moraine that was left behind after the last Ice Age, trapping the glacial waters inland. With its many islands, this narrow lake feeds poetic thought with its scenic beauty. Hiking along the shores of the lake is a popular activity. There are many great swimming spots in Lake Farris. Both beach and soft rocks to relax on and jump in the water from. Going for a late night swim at the end of the summer is something magical.



The Farris Bridge (Farrisbrua)

The Farris Bridge was finished in 2018 and has become a landmark in Larvik. The unique bridge is known for its challenging and quite uncommon design.

Mølen

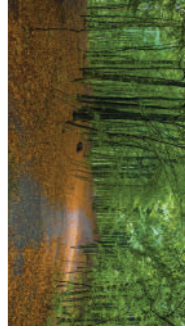
Mølen is a part of one the world's largest monuments from the last ice age and is a piece of a huge gravel deposit encircling all of Scandinavia. It was formed at the margin of the inland ice during the period 12650 to 12350 years before the present. In Southeastern Norway, the gravel deposit is called "the Ra".



Colin Archers house at Tollerodden
In 1826 William Archer bought the property and laid out the gardens. His descendants kept the property for the next hundred years. The world famous naval architect Colin Archer was born and raised in the house, located at Tollerodden.



Herregården (Herregården)
Herregården - the count's resident, was made for the count Ulrik Fredrik Gyldenløve, stadholder and owner of Larvik county. The construction started in 1674 and was finished in 1677 just in time for Gyldenløve's third wedding. The building was protected in 1923, and it's now a part of Larvik Museum. In the east wing there's a cafe that sells coffee and pancakes. On the first floor there is remains of an old classroom as it once were used as a school.



The Beech Tree Forest (Bøkeskogen)

Norway's largest and the worlds northernmost beech tree forest. The forest is used all year round for cultural and recreational activities by locals and tourists alike. The highest point is called "The Belleveue". It is situated in the north-western part of the area. This place gives you an excellent view of the Farris lake, and some good rest for your legs.
